Bank Account Scam

The Federal Reserve Bank of New York reports that scammers are telling people they can pay their bills using so-called "secret accounts" or "Social Security trust accounts" and routing numbers at Federal Reserve Banks. In exchange for personal information, like Social Security numbers, people get what they think is a bank account number at a Federal Reserve Bank. But this really is just a way to get your personal information, which scammers can then sell or use to commit fraud, like identity theft. Keep in mind that people do not have accounts at Federal Reserve Banks. Only banks can bank at the Federal Reserve.
